Hi-vis vests should be worn by staff at front and back of group and staff should carry torches (at dusk and night) to warn oncoming vehicles of group presence.	5	1	5
Slips and Trips	All	3	4	12	Warn participants to take extra care on uneven ground and encourage those in front to warn of specific hazards. Ensure all participants have suitable footwear before departing. Make use of torches where necessary.	2	3	6
Getting Lost	Participants	3	3	9	Ensure the group stays together and count numbers at regular intervals. Position a member of staff at the front and the back of the group.	3	1	3
